#### Manuscript Specifications

- **Abstract Length:** 250–300 words
- **Full Paper Length:** 5,000–7,000 words
- **Language:** Papers may be submitted in **English or Hindi**
- **Referencing Style:** APA (7th Edition)
- Papers must be **original, unpublished, and plagiarism-free**.
- Similarity index should be within **acceptable academic limits**.
- All submissions will undergo a **Double-Blind Peer Review Process**.

- File name should contain Author Name and Short Title.
- Joint papers are allowed; however, each presenting author must register separately.

Manuscripts submitted in Hindi must be typed in **Unicode font (Mangal or equivalent Unicode format)** to ensure smooth peer review, editing, and publication processing. Non-Unicode fonts will not be accepted.
